



Dr. Pierre Maggi was trained at Strasbourg University (France), where he specialised in astrophysics at Strasbourg Astronomical Observatory. He obtained his PhD at the Max-Planck Institute for extraterrestrial Physics in Germany, focusing on the supernova remnant population of the Large Magellanic Cloud.

After post-doctoral studies at CEA Saclay near Paris, he came back in 2018 to his alma mater as an astronomer at Strasbourg Observatory.

When he is not teaching to the next generation of astrophysicists, his main research focuses on the high-energy cosmic phenomena occurring at the end of stars' life.

In parallel he is actively involved in the development and preparation of future X-ray space observatories. The XMM2Athena project and the tools developed will help to maximise the scientific return of existing or future missions. He lives in Strasbourg.
